

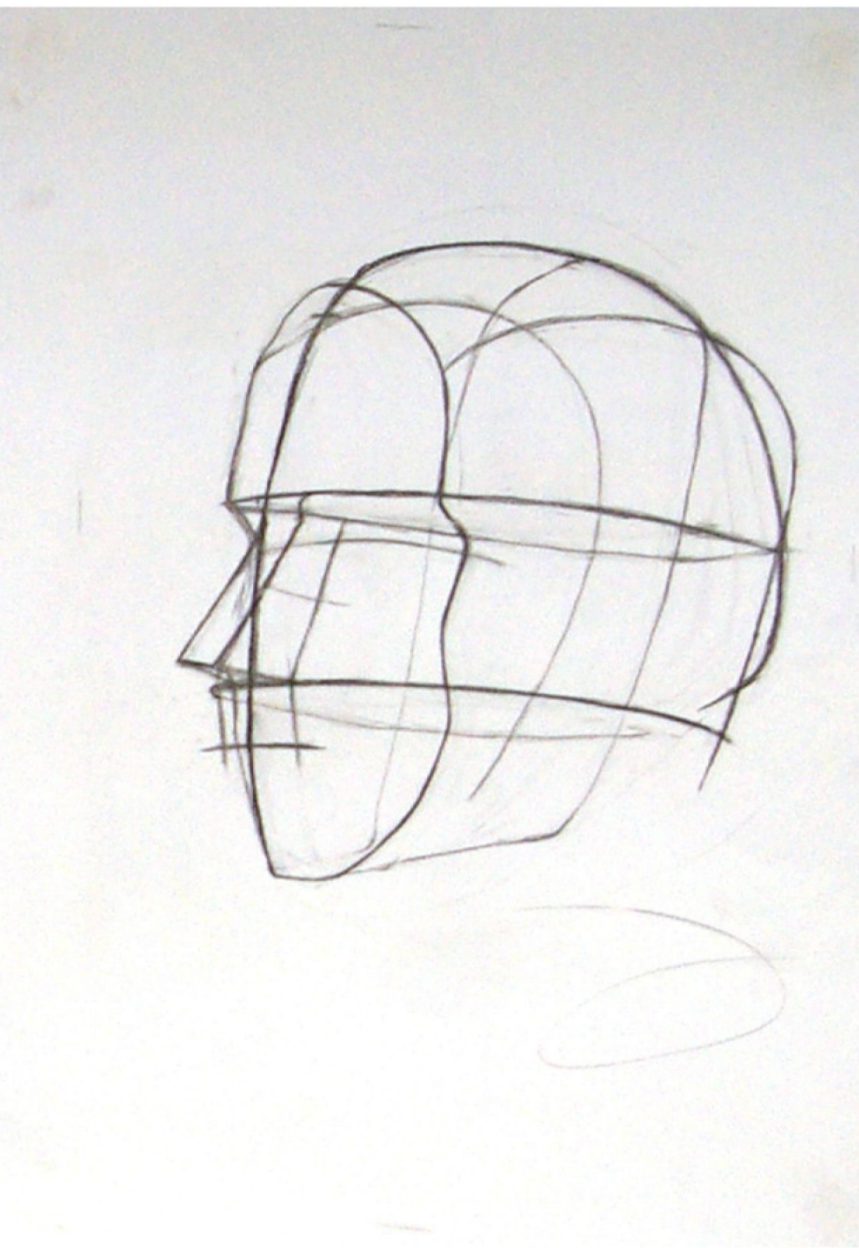
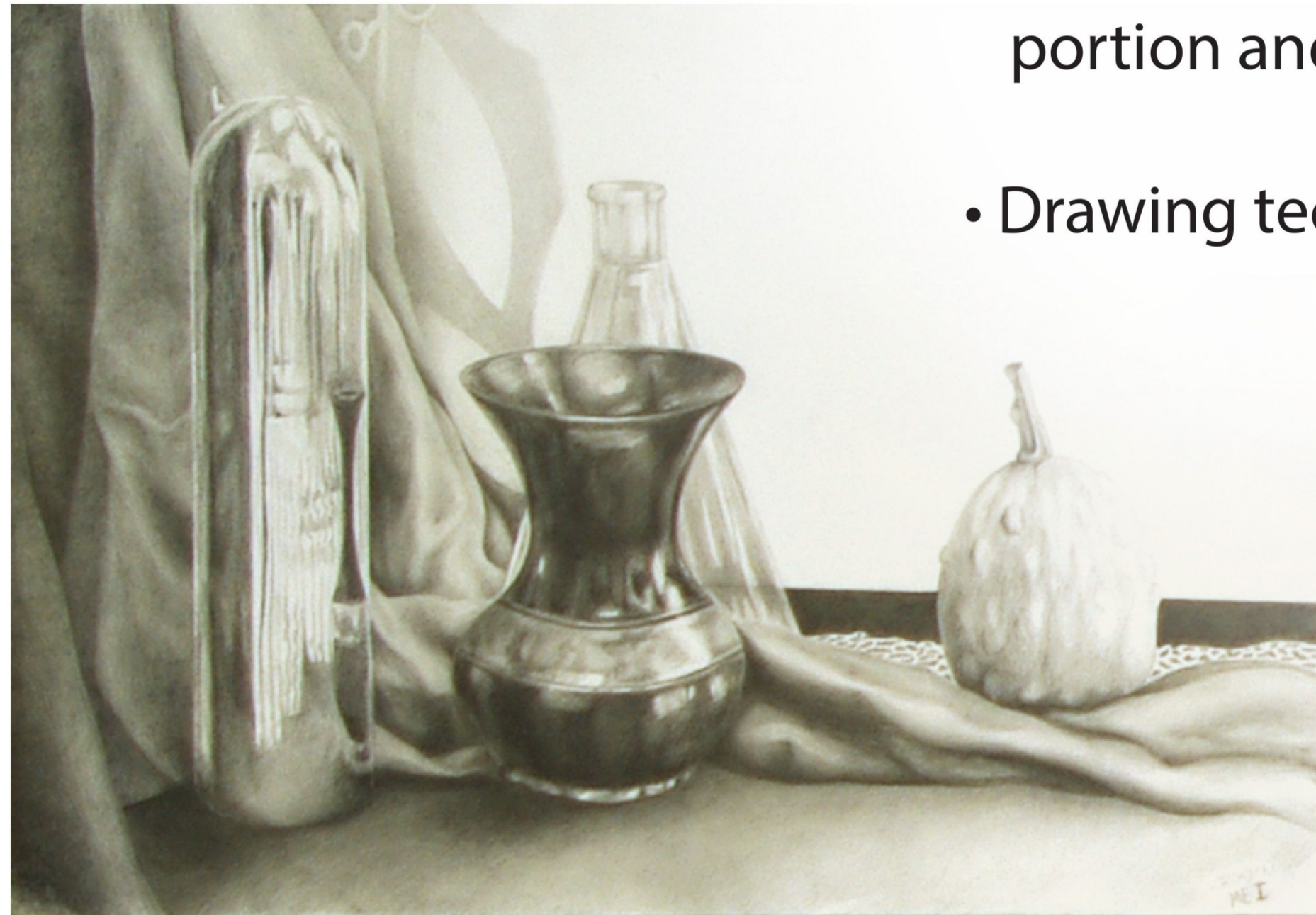
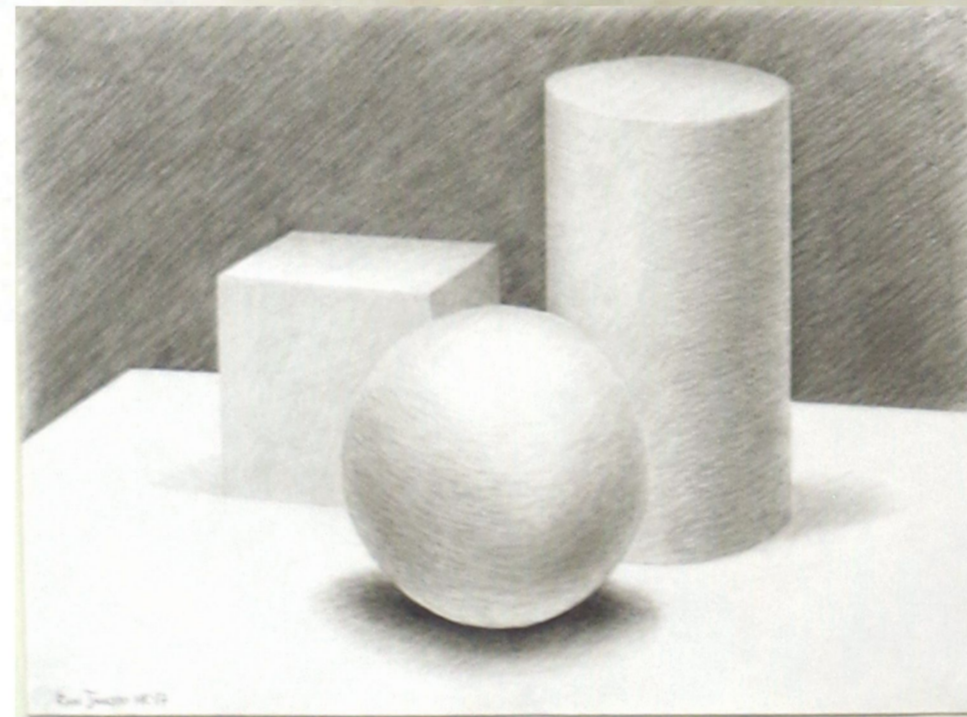
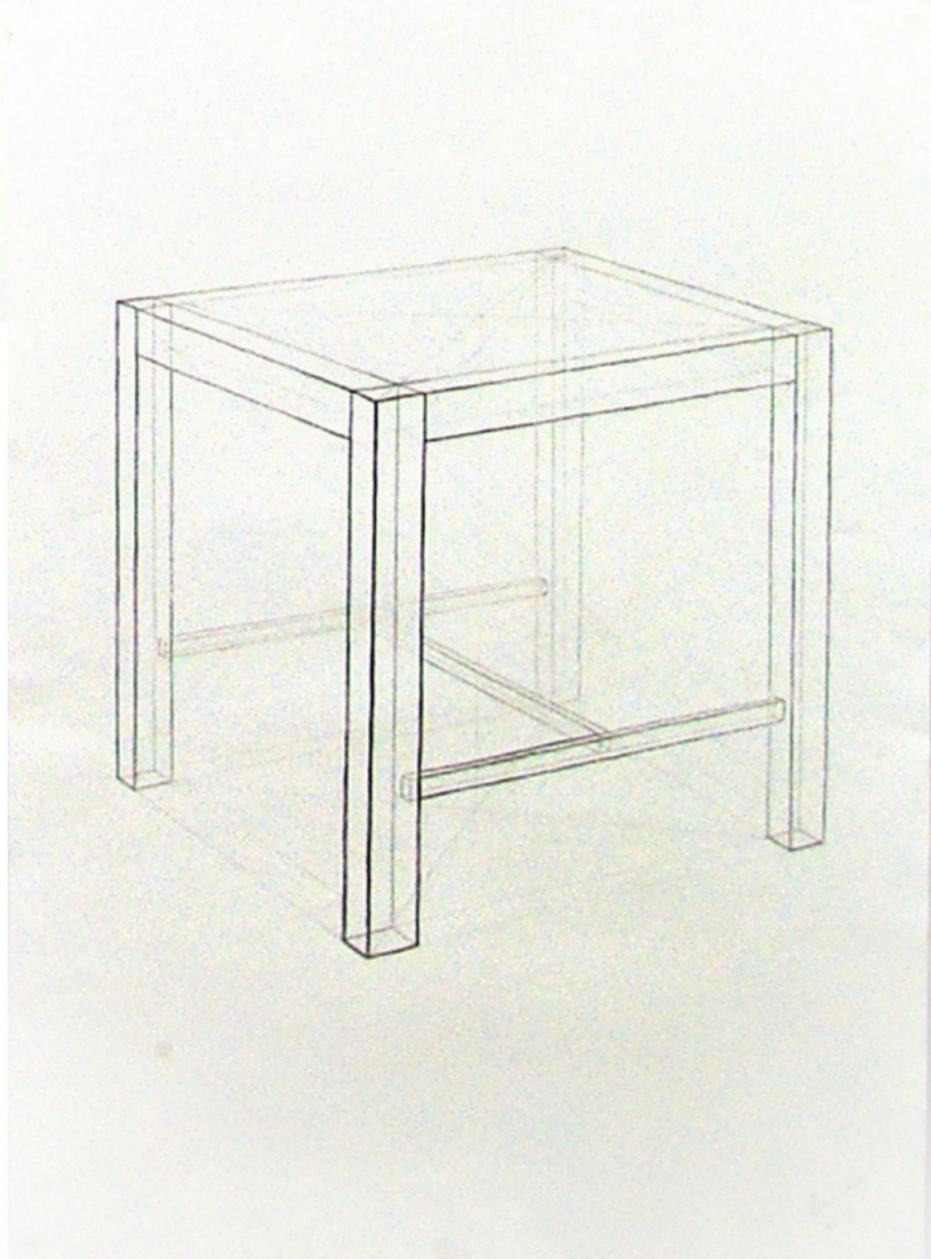
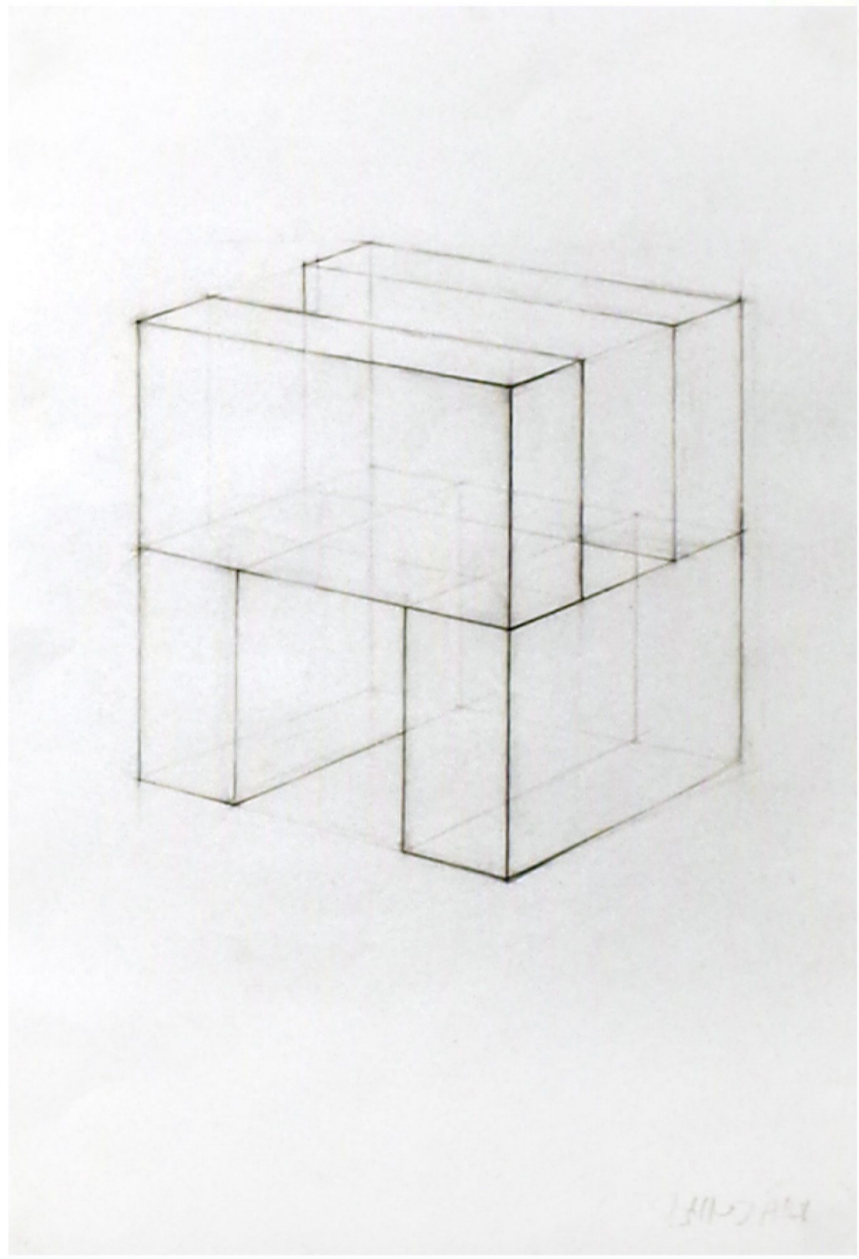
DRAWING CLASS AT TARTU ART COLLEGE
